The "Airports" database gathers data on more than 2500 airports world-wide, collected from a variety of sources every year since 1970. Mainly the number of passengers, aircraft movements and freight.

### **FRANCE**

On March 17, the European Union closed its borders, and France started its lockdown, causing air traffic to fall drastically. When the lockdown was lifted in mid-May, domestic travel saw a slight improvement.

International Air Passengers represent 79,5% of Air traffic in France, but it has not shown signs of recovery especially outside of Europe has not shown signs of recovery, when domestic traffic is expected to return to normal in 2021.

Paris Airports (Charles de Gaulle and Orly) have particularly suffered from the lockdown and borders closing. Orly Airport was shut down from March 31 to June 26. But the traffic started to recover slowly since the reopening and in July it ensured more than one quarter of its previous traffic.


However, for a big touristic hub like France, the Covid-19 crisis represents years of damage to not only air traffic, but the whole economy.





### UNITED KINGDOM

The UK one of the epicenters of the pandemic in Europe. A lockdown began on the March 23 and is scheduled to progressively being eased over the next few months.


On July 10, travel restrictions were lifted for over 75 countries. UK residents are slowly starting to travel abroad again, with Heathrow Airport recording an improvement in number of passengers in July 2020 compared to June 2020. However, a lot of air routes remain grounded for passengers have to undergo a fourteen-day guarantine.

Heathrow airport is also advocating for mass testing in airports to both reopen routes safely and ensure the public's safety.


As the most important hub in Europe with Heathrow, International air travel represents 91,3% of all air passengers.

### **NORWAY**

Norway has managed to maintain control over the virus on its soil with a high number of tests and travel restrictions. A national lockdown started on March 12. On March 16, non-residents were banned from entering Norway and there was a general ban on visits to Norway through airports. Domestic traveled has continued without restrictions and has recovered quickly from -83% in April to more than -40% in July.


Now the Government is advising against Domestic travel that is not necessary and is also recommending avoiding International travel, except for a few countries with low transmission levels.

Short-haul flights were resumed on July 1 by Norwegian Airlines. Still, anyone returning from a foreign country must undergo a ten-day quarantine.



### **GREECE**


Greece has been praised by many for how it handled the virus on a national scale. A national lockdown took place from March 23 to May 11. However, closed borders were-to-be a catastrophe for an economy that relies heavily on tourism. Borders reopened on June 15, and the government focused on restarting the tourism industry from July 1.

Since tourism has restarted, Greece is still recording numbers that are far from its 2019 passenger record, with less people visiting Greece from January to June 2020 compared to the month of July 2019 only. Greece is also taking in consideration a second lockdown with the slight rise of new cases coming with flows of tourists.



### **TURKEY**


The country was less impacted than most of its European neighbors. The lockdown was less restrictive, only the young and elderly were quarantined and there was a mandatory curfew on weekends and holidays from April to June.

As many other countries, the number of passengers plummeted in April and May. Turkey suspended its foreign flights on March 27 but is now progressively resuming international flights by destination. Domestic flights are also on the right path to recover, climbing from - 99,6% in April to -49,7% in June compared to 2019.


From January to June 2020, over 14 million passengers passed through Istanbul Airport. Turkey's air traffic could be bouncing back from the crisis already, with the government putting efforts on regaining activity of Istanbul Airport.

### **SOUTH KOREA**

South Korea is often praised for how it handled the pandemic. There was no lockdown and the spread of the virus was limited through mass testing and social distancing measures.


However, South Korea has largely restricted international travel, to keep the virus contained on its soil. Since April 1, every person entering South Korea must undergo a fourteen-day quarantine.

On the other hand, domestic travel has been doing pretty well compared to other countries, it fell to -57,1% in March 2020 compared to March 2019 and the latest number for July 2020 shows that it has only fallen 10% compared to July 2019.


The Domestic travel should recover quickly, but the International was representing 65,9% of Air passengers last year.

### **THAILAND**

With 75%, of its traffic being International, and 20% of its GDP coming from Travel & Tourism, Thailand is facing economic turmoil. But it has successfully controlled the virus on its territory.


On April 1, borders were closed to foreigners, excluding diplomats and people with work permit. Since then, Domestic flights have been fully operating since June, but nothing has changed for International flights but a few more exceptions.


Like its Asian neighbors, Thailand seems to be betting on closed borders to maintain control on the virus on a national scale and is favoring security over air traffic.


Combined to fear that has pushed people away from air travel, governments measures might just make it a very long process to recover from the pandemic, even if the national damage of the virus was limited.

### **INDIA**

With the second largest population in the world and a very high density, containing the virus quickly became a key stake for India.

On March 22, all international flights were suspended, and they still are now. There was a nationwide lockdown from March 24 to May 31, that has been progressively eased.

India resumed domestic passenger flights on May 25 but Indian airlines are only allowed to operate 45% of their pre-COVID domestic flights, and the load factor of planes is only of about 50 to 60%.

Domestic air travel could recover rather quickly from the crisis, which would represent a big step since Indian domestic traffic is the third busiest in the world and represents 65,9% of air passengers in the country.



### **CHINA**

China was the first country to be hit by the virus and has started to recover rather quickly. China can rely on a massive domestic market which makes up to 88,8% of Air passengers. Domestic Air traffic never completely crumbled down and has now recovered from -84,8% in March to -33,5% in June.


Since Chinese Airlines rely on Domestic travel for much of their revenue, they should recover quickly and at a steadier pace than their European and American counterparts.

International travel towards China is still very limited as the government insists on closing borders to maintain control on the national territory. Anyone entering the Chinese soil must undergo a fourteen-day quarantine.



### **SOUTH AFRICA**

Fifth highest number of total cases in the world today, South Africa also chose to put a lockdown on its economy and population. On March 26, a national lockdown was announced. It was gradually eased starting from May 1.

South African Airways who was already not in good shape before the crisis, has taken a toll with airplanes being grounded. The Government is currently in talks to sell the company.


International and Domestic passengers flight were prohibited during lockdown. The number of Domestic passengers has shown signs of recovery, but South Africa remains closed for International tourism until February 2021.

Domestic travel represents 69% of total Air passengers in South Africa, hotels, restaurants and businesses are finding ways to attract a Domestic clientele in order to palliate the lack of International tourists.



### **UNITED STATES**


The US have been hit hard by the pandemic and unfortunately the virus continues to spread on American soil. Each state has followed a different path concerning the fight against the virus. Since the lockdown in March, states have been trying to relaunch the economy, but with new cases rising, some, such as California or Texas, are pausing the reopening process.


Domestic travel has picked up from its all-time-low in April but is recovering less quickly than thought. Big airlines have received over \$50bn in government aid and are barred from furloughing workers.

The future of the biggest domestic market in the world is uncertain with stagnation in flights for key states and with the virus far from being controlled on a national scale.

## **MEXICO**


Mexico played a national distancing initiative, shutdown all but necessary economic activity from March 23 to May 30 and began reopening in June. Vacation destinations for tourism such as Cancun were reopened on June 8. Mexico is progressively easing its restrictions even though the number of cases is rising, and Mexico has the third highest toll of the pandemic.

Air travel was never completely halted and was not restricted. At present, no quarantine and no test are required to enter the Mexican soil. However, International travel is still very timid. Domestic travel is expected to recover to 75% of its previous number by year-end. Volaris, biggest carrier in Mexico and low-cost company, relied heavily on the Domestic market and is showing promising signs.



### **COLOMBIA**

Colombia has been on a national lockdown since March 25 and thus has the longest running lockdown in the world.

Because of the lockdown, almost all air traffic has been stopped in Colombia since April.


Domestic air service was planned to be relaunched on September 1. Bogota's El Dorado Airport is set to reopen in September by testing first an air route between Bogota and one of Colombia's main cities, Cartagena, or Barranquilla.

With 66% of its traffic being domestic, Colombia's traffic should recover rather quickly when airports reopen. However, international air traffic still plays an important part in the country's economy, and the long lockdown will definitely make it a challenge for the economy to bounce back.


